rubber? / is Max's pen?...

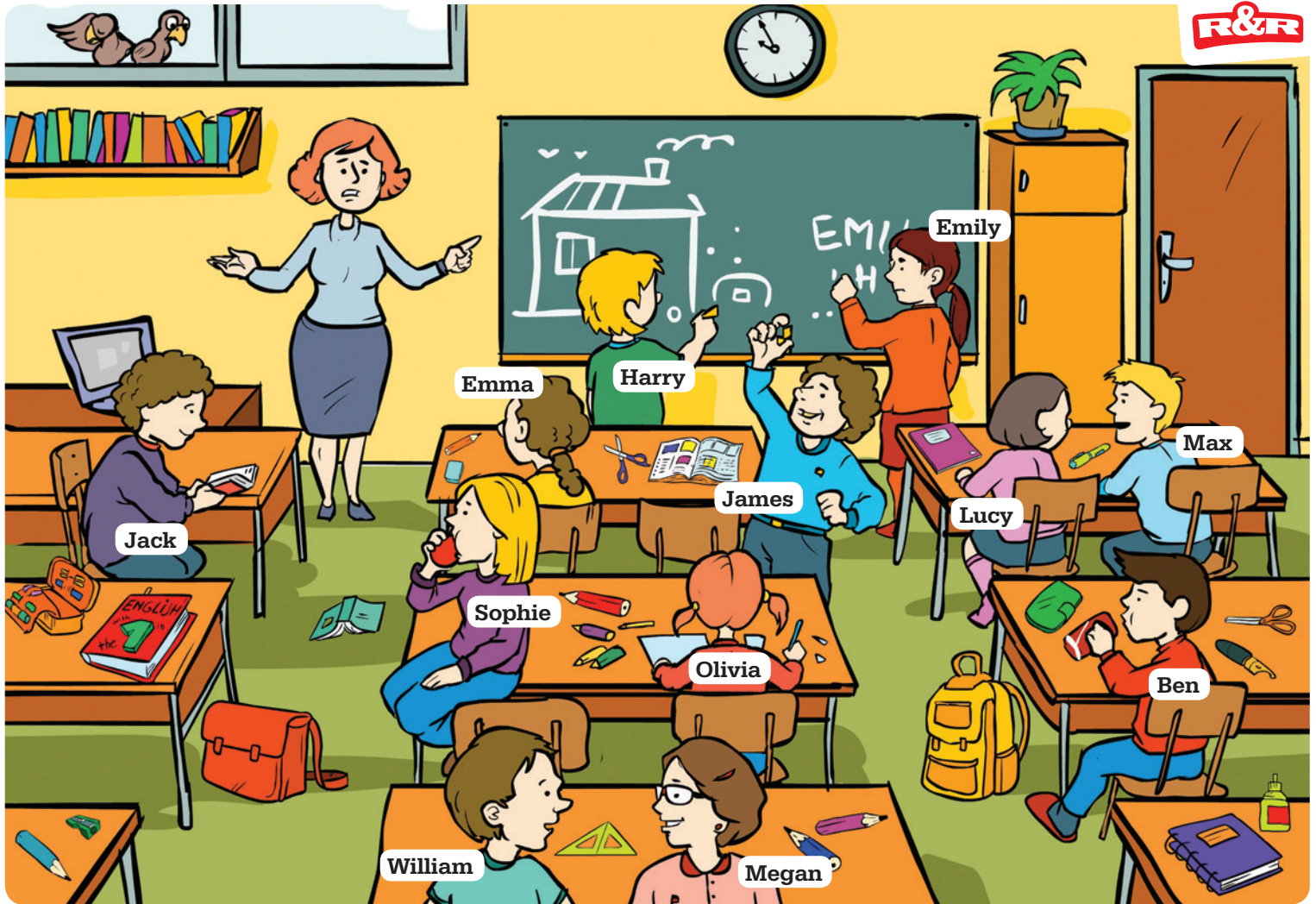
Guessing Game
