

WHAT'S THE WEATHER LIKE?

Seasons

spring (March, April, May), summer (June, July, August), autumn (*BrE*) / fall (*AmE*) (September, October, November), winter (December, January, February)

Weather Vocabulary

cold, hot, warm, sunny, dry, wet, foggy, cloudy, freezing, rainy, windy, stormy, ice, rain, snow, wind, fog, a rainbow, the sky, a storm, the sun, a cloud

Look at the Picture

What's the season? What time of year is it?

It's spring / summer / winter / autumn / fall. It's a(n) summer / spring / winter / autumn / fall day.

What's the weather like in spring / summer / autumn / winter in each picture?

SPRING: It's cold / warm / foggy / rainy / raining (right now) / wet / stormy / windy. It's getting warmer. The sky is cloudy. There's a rainbow in the sky.

SUMMER: It's hot and sunny. It's hot and dry. The sun is shining. The sky is blue.

AUTUMN: It's cold / foggy / wet / stormy / windy / cloudy / rainy / raining (right now). It's getting colder.

The sky is cloudy / dark. There's a strong wind. There are leaves on the ground. A storm is coming.

WINTER: It's freezing (= very cold) / cold / snowy / snowing (right now). There's ice / snow on the ground / on the trees.

What are the children doing?

They're walking in the rain. They're carrying umbrellas. They're wearing trousers / jackets / coats / wellies / boots / swimsuits (mainly for girls) / swimming trunks (mainly for boys) / dressed warmly. They're lying on the grass / sunbathing. They're flying kites. They're playing in the snow / building a snowman.

Talk about Seasons and Weather

With a partner, practise asking and answering the questions. Take it in turns.

What time of year is it now? What's the weather like today? What's the weather like in spring / summer / autumn / winter? What's your favourite season? Why? What's your favourite weather? What kind of weather do you like?

Why? What do you usually do in spring / summer / autumn / winter?

Guessing Game

- 1 Student A looks at the picture and chooses one season. Student A doesn't tell Student B.
- 2 Student B asks three questions about the weather or the children in the picture. Student B isn't allowed to ask the following questions: *Is it spring...?* Student A can answer with "yes" or "no".
- 3 Student A answers the questions.
- 4 Student B guesses which season Student A is thinking of.

Example:

B: Is the weather rainy?

A: No, it isn't.

B: Is it windy?

A: No, it isn't.

B: Are the children playing in the snow?

A: Yes, they are.

B: It's winter.


A: Yes, it is.
