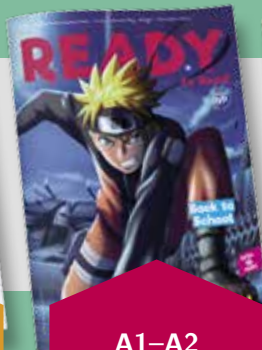

WATER CHILDREN

These village children in the Philippines have a long way to school. There is no road. There is a river, but no **bridge**³ or boat. They use⁴ **tyre tubes**⁵ to go down the river! It looks very fun, but it's dangerous after rain.



THE FLYING GIRL

Daisy is nine. She lives in the Colombian rainforest. Her school is across a big canyon. There is no bridge. There is a **cable**⁶, one km long and 400 m above the river. There is a **pulley**⁷ and a **hook**⁸ on it. Every school day, she puts her five-year-old brother in a bag. She hooks the bag to the pulley. She hooks a seat to the pulley, too. And they zzzzzzzip⁹ down the cable at 80 kph*!



A TIRING¹⁰ TREK


Ladakh in India is a region in the Himalaya mountains. Many villages are very, very small. Children must walk a long way to school. A very long way: more than a week! The walk is over **icy**¹¹ mountains. They only do it twice a year – to get to school and go home. They have to live at the school all year.
