Practise Simple Questions

What animals are there in the zoo?

What are the animals doing?

Which animals are eating / drinking / sleeping / playing / flying / swimming / climbing?

Where is the frog / a boy / the fish / the spider / the Easter Bunny?

How many fish / squirrels / ants / birds / children / baby animals / Easter eggs are there?

Practise Sentences

Talk about the animals at the zoo. What are they doing in the picture?

The bear / foxes / fish / squirrel / monkeys / is / are eating / drinking / sleeping / playing / flying / swimming / climbing.

You are an animal expert. Give your partner a tour (= prohlídka) and teach them about one of the animals.

Squirrels / rabbits / lizards / moose / bears / birds / hedgehogs eat grass / meat / fruit. They drink water / milk. They've got two / four / six / eight / no legs / wings / a tail / ears. They live on land / in the water. They sleep a lot / at night / during the day / all winter.



Guessing Games

1 I'm looking at...

Play a guessing game. Look at one thing in the picture and make a sentence about it. Your classmates can guess what it is.

I'm looking at something green / brown / big / small / scary / friendly.

I'm looking at something that's eating / drinking / sleeping / playing / flying / swimming / climbing.

I'm looking at something that eats meat / flies / sleeps at night / is dangerous.

2 What is it?

Choose one animal or person from the picture. Don't say who it is. The other students must ask questions to guess what you have chosen. You can only answer "yes" or "no".

Examples:

- *Is it an animal / a boy / a man / a woman / big / small / blue / red?*
- *Does it eat grass / fruit / meat?*
- *Is it sleeping / eating / flying / drinking / sleeping / playing / climbing?*
